# NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

(State CEQA Guidelines, sections 15072 and 15073)

A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) has been prepared by the Foothill/Eastern Transportation Corridor Agency (F/ETCA), as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.), for the **Saddle Club Site Use Plan Implementation Project** (project) in Trabuco Canyon, California. The MND was prepared in compliance with the requirements of CEQA, the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15000 et seq.) and Appendix H to the F/ETCA Administrative Code Procedures for Implementing CEQA.

### **Project location:**

The project site is located at **31101 Live Oak Canyon Road, Trabuco Canyon**, California, in unincorporated Orange County. It is bordered by the Live Oak Canyon Road/Trabuco Canyon Road and O'Neill Regional Park to the West and South, and the Orange County Transportation Authority's Wren's View Preserve to the North and East.

#### **Project Description:**

The proposed project involves the demolition, removal, salvage and/or disposal of materials associated with previous equestrian uses of the site; removal of ornamental vegetation; installation of trail signage and appurtenant structures including rest benches, as well as ongoing operations and maintenance activities as may be necessary.

A government records search conducted by Overland, Pacific & Cutler in 2017 determined that the project site is not included on the list of hazardous waste sites compiled pursuant to Government Code Section 65963.5.
